Animal Farm by George Orwell was first published in 1945 by Martin Secker & Warburg Ltd, London.

The present illustrated edition was printed in 2000 in 175 numbered copies for the members of 'De Roos', Utrecht, with an additional few copies for the collaborators and the archives.

It was set in Plantin, printed on Butterfly Pink by Veldwijk-van Loon Grafische Bedrijven bv, Waddinxveen and bound by Boekbinderij van Waarden bv, Zaandam.

This edition was illustrated by Frits Frietman.
